



SCHOOL UNIFORM – St Mary's Primary School – September 2018

Our aim is to keep the children looking their natural age and neat and tidy. The children act as ambassadors for the school, through the way they dress.

Items of uniform may be worn in any sensible and neat combination according to the weather.

(Second-hand uniform is available. Please contact the School Office).

ALL PROPERTY MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE OWNER'S NAME

UNIFORM

Reception to Year 2 – Any combination but no shirt and tie

Years 3 -6 – Any combination

Shirt and tie or white polo shirt (may be plain, but preferably with blue stripe and logo*)

Navy Jumper or cardigan (may be plain, but preferably with logo*)

Mid-grey or charcoal grey long or short trousers

Mid-grey or black socks

Navy or Black shoes or sandals (no trainers) (no heels higher than 2cm)

Navy skirt/pinafore dress (knee length only) or navy tailored trousers or tailored shorts (knee length)

Blue and white checked dress

White socks or navy tights (**not** trainer/sports socks)

Physical Education

St Mary's polo shirt **with logo***

St Mary's sweatshirt **with logo***

Navy tailored shorts (not football shorts, leggings or lycra. *Shorts with logo* optional*)

Navy Jogging trousers

Trainers (for outdoor use) from Year 3

Velcro or elastic Plimsolls – Reception to Yr 2

PE bag with drawstring (soft bag only)

any colour reception – Year 2,

house colours from Year 3

Reception to Yr 2 - Spare set of clothes including underwear and socks in PE bag

One piece swimming costume (girls Years 2 - 6)

Swimming trunks (boys Years 2 -6)

Swimming Cap (available from the office)

Outdoor Wear

Sensible coat

Navy fleece with/without logo*

Reversible coat with/without logo*

Hat & gloves when very cold

Sun hat when hot

No hooded sweatshirts

Wellington Boots as necessary

Bags

Reception to Year 2 – Home reader bags with school logo in a variety of colours

Year 3 to Year 6 – Navy Home reader bags with school logo or small bag to fit on peg in cloakroom

Hair - All children, girls and boys, are requested to tie hair up where it is long enough to do so. Currently fashioned hairstyles should be kept for holidays and are not in-keeping with the school uniform policy. **Hair bands should be navy, white or blue and white checked.**

***Items of uniform with a logo are available from the school suppliers, SWOTS (of Reigate) or PMG Schoolwear (on-line or phone ordering). (To contact them, follow the link on St Mary's website). They also carry stocks of all the other items listed above (those can also be bought from many other suppliers).**

Jewellery

On Health and Safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are earrings studs in pierced ears, small objects of religious significance and a watch. We ask the children to remove these objects during PE and games to prevent them from causing injury.
