Dear Parents and Carers,

St Mary's have managed to secure some spaces for Bikeability Training (Level 2) to be completed at school the weeks commencing 3rd December and 10th December. Due to booking and time constraints there are only 40 spaces available (20 each week). In order to take part children must have a road-worthy bicycle and suitable helmet. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first served basis. During the training the children will learn how to use their bicycle safely on roads and near traffic with certified instructors. The children have 4 sessions (one each day for approximately 1 1/2 hours). Please note that bicycles can be brought in the morning of the first session or the night before and will be safely stored indoors overnight.

Level 2 outcomes

- How to start and finish a journey
- Be aware of potential hazards
- Understand how and when to signal intentions to other road users
- Understand where to ride on roads being used
- Pass parked or slower moving vehicles
- Pass side road
- Turning into and out of road junctions- left from minor to major road, left from major to minor road, right from minor to major road, right from major to minor road
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of the decisions you make while cycling
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of the Highway Code

Successful candidates will be sent a consent form and additional information to complete in advance of the training. We will ask for payment at this time which will be £30. Please do not send money in yet.
