As part of our History topic, we will be visiting Brooklands Museum. In History we have been looking at changes in power (the monarchy) and changes in technology. All children will be going on **Friday 16th November**. The cost of this trip is included in the Year 5 trips payment plan. We do have a very small number of places for parent helpers on this trip, so let us know if you can help via class dojo.

We are taking part in 3 different workshops throughout the day: Gateways to the World: Land, Gateways to the World: Air and Marvellous Mechanisms. The Gateways to the World workshops tie in really well with our learning in History as the children will have looked at changes in naval ship building over time. Marvellous Mechanisms helps children to understand how machines work which supports our Science learning later in the year when we look at gears, levers and pulleys.
