The talk will be hosted in the **infant hall** on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> January** between **7pm-8pm** and will follow with a question and answer session. *It is suitable for both junior and infant parents.* The talk will cover a range of topics which will help keep your child safe in the virtual space. These include:

- Scrapping the stereotype – we are all vulnerable.
- 'Stranger Danger' in the virtual space.
- What is grooming? How do we recognise it?
- Having that awkward parent-child conversation, gaining trust and sharing concerns about online safety.
- Where to find helpful resources/help each other.
- What to do if you are worried – how to report concerns and where.
- How to interact safely online – the lessons Breck's story teaches us.
