English Learning

Our topic this half term is 'Superheroes'. We will be looking closely at the texts 'Traction Man and Supertato'. We will be immersing ourselves in the text, discussing the different language used and writing stories based on our own superheroes. As part of our Literacy, we will look at different comics and discuss the ways these give use information.



Topic Learning

Science – Our topic will be plants. We will be looking closely and observing plants over time.
History – We will be exploring toys in the past, present and what we think toys will be like in the future.
RE – We will start to look at Islam and what it means to be a Muslim.
PSHE & British Values – We will look at relationships and explore feelings within the context of our important relationships including family and friends.
Computing – We will learn how to explore the internet safely.
