English Learning

Our topic this half term is 'Dinosaurs'. In our Literacy lessons, we will be focusing on different poems, reading two different dinosaur stories with a focus on spelling common exception words and cursive handwriting.



Topic Learning

Science – We will continue to look at different plants and begin to investigate.

Geography – We will be exploring our local area and conducting some simple fieldwork, including thinking about how we can improve our local area.

RE – We will be looking at different parables from the Bible.

Computing – We will study photography, mimicking artists and taking our own photos.

Music – We will continue to listen to and appraise a range of music.

Art & DT - We will be designing and using papier Mache to create our own dinosaur eggs.

PE – We will continue to be like collaboration kid and play team games.

PSHE – We will be discussing transition to year 2 and talking about our hopes for next year.

Maths Learning

This half term we will have a strong focus on place value, counting to and from 100 and correctly forming all of our numbers. Alongside this, we will remind ourselves of 2d and 3d shapes as well as recapping fractions.

We will be looking at different dinosaurs over the half term. If you would like to do some research to support your child that would be great. We are happy to have any information brought in to class to share and display.
