Weekly Homework

- ▶ Reading – 5 times a week. Please record in the communication book/homework diary & sign by Monday morning. These will be checked on a Monday.
 - ▶ Spelling – Set on a Friday, tested the following Friday. Children need to know the meaning of the words in context, as well as how to spell them. Learning using *look, say, cover, write, check* and writing sentences to apply.
 - ▶ Times tables – Tested on a Thursday. Each week different times tables will be identified in the communication book/homework diary.
