Dear Parents and Carers,

We have several exciting trips and events happening over the remainder of the academic year. This letter details all of the school trips and visits for which we require a financial contribution this year. Please note that other unforeseen events may be added (this would be for only a small fee) and that this payment plan does not include swimming fees.

Bough Beach Reservoir Water Treatment Works – Wednesday 25th or Thursday 26th March

We will be visiting Bough Beech Reservoir's water treatment works in the Spring term, focussing how the water is treated and the role of the reservoir in the the water cycle. This trip links to our science topic of the water cycle and our geography topic of rivers. 4T and 4L will visit on Wednesday 25th March, with 4H and 4M visiting on Thursday 26th March. The cost of this trip covers the coach journey to and from the treatment works.

RHS Wisley – Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th June

As part of our Science learning the summer term, we will be looking at how plants have adapted to suit their environment at RHS Wisley. 4H & 4M will visit on Wednesday 24th June and 4L & 4T will visit on Thursday 25th June. The cost of this trip covers the coach journey to and from the gardens.

Master Park – Summer Term

Children will visit the park alongside their learning in Geography and Science to put their mapping skills to the test and explore habitats in our local environment. There is no cost for this.

In order for the visits and events to take place we must ask for a voluntary contribution of £18.00. Please be aware that if insufficient funds are received then the trips may not be able to go ahead. Please pay for these activities on SCOPAY by Friday 20th March.

For all off-site events a letter/permission slip will be sent out explaining in more detail what children are required to bring and timings.

We would like all children to be able to benefit from these extended educational experiences. If, for any reason, you feel unable to make the voluntary contribution please contact myself, Mrs Lewis or Mrs Woodward who will discuss options available to you.
