Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

We have many exciting events happening over the coming academic year, which will make learning great fun for the children. This includes a **one night residential trip to Ufton Court** in October. This is the fourth year we have run this trip.

4SW & 4L will be going on the trip on Wednesday 6th October and returning on Thursday 7th October. 4M & 4CW will be going on the trip on Thursday 7th October and returning on Friday 8th October, so all four classes will be on site together on the Thursday.

I will be giving a talk about this trip on **Tuesday 7th September at 3.45pm in the Junior school hall (subject to changing online based upon COVID guidance)**. All information and materials used at this talk will be made available to parents afterwards.

The itinerary includes: an Anglo-Saxon Banquet, Saxon arts, crafts and games, Saxon crime & punishment and the highlight of the trip – a raid by the Vikings! The trip is a wonderful experience and allows children to develop confidence and independence.

In order for the trip to take place, we must ask parents/carers for a payment of £129 per child. *No payment is required from children currently eligible for free school meals.*

There are 3 ways to pay (payments to be made online via Scopay):

1. **Single payment of £129 (our preferred option!)** as soon as possible and by 10th September at the latest
2. 2 payments: deposit of £70 (required to secure a place on the trip) as soon as possible and by 10th September at the latest. Further payment of £59 in October.
3. 3 payments: deposit of £70 (required to secure a place on the trip) as soon as possible and by 10th September. 2 further payments of £29.50 due in October and November.
