Dear Parents and Carers,

The infant library is finally ready to go! This means that in addition to weekly library visits, the children will be able to sign out books to take home to enjoy reading with you!

The library system is a computerised system that ensures that we know who has taken what book. Once a book has been signed out, it can be kept for up to two weeks. For now, children will be allowed to take home just one book.

Year 2 pupils who have completed the reading scheme and are choosing their own reading books may be able to choose 2: one for practising reading and one to share with you. These books may be harder or easier than the book supporting their decoding skills.

If children return the book later than the date expected there are no late fees. However, we do expect all books to be returned and will ask for payment or a replacement for lost books. The books children choose may be above (or below) their own reading level. Please note that the purpose of reading books from the library is purely for enjoyment and therefore the books may need to be read by you.

In addition to library books, children will soon be coming home with 'Read Write Inc. Book Bag Books'. These should be read by the children and are phonically matched to what they are learning at school. A separate letter will follow after half term explaining how you can use these books to support your child with decoding and learning to read.
