A hugely successful **'Trash for Cash'** litter picking day where St. Marys children and parents, grandparents and extended family members, and dogs, walked across Oxted and surrounding areas to pick up litter whilst being sponsored to raise further funds.

On 9 July the St. Mary's Reps organised a **Splashdance**; pupils took to the field, danced, played, and ate sweets! A child's dream. It was a wonderful afternoon which everyone enjoyed.

Just to give you an idea, Rebecca has been involved in raising approximately **£46,133** for St. Mary's.


