Our rehearsals for Peter Pan are really swinging into action! Here is some important information about performance times and costumes.

PERFORMANCES

TEAM A

Tuesday 23rd May 9:15 am; Thursday 25th May 6:30 pm

TEAM B

Tuesday 23rd May 6:30 pm; Thursday 25th May 9:15 am

Children who are part of 'Team A' or 'Team B' have larger roles and each have two performances – one day time and one evening. All other children are performing their role in 4 performances. In addition to these performances there will be two dress rehearsals in school time where the children will perform to the rest of the school (Team A Friday 19th May, Team B Monday 22nd May).

If you are unsure which team your child is in, please send us a Dojo to find out. It is clearly noted on the top of the children's scripts. Information about tickets for the performances will follow soon.

COSTUMES

We are hoping you will be able to source some parts of costumes yourself. Costumes need to be in school in a named bag by Friday 12th May. Please let us know if you need help sourcing any part of the costume.

Pirates (including Smee & Ship's cook) – Plain or striped t-shirts, cut-off trousers, belt or sash type belt, bandana, eye patch (optional)

Wild Warriors (including Chief and Tigerlily) – plain black t shirts (long or short sleeved), black trousers or leggings

Mermaids – Costume will be provided

Forest fairies – black knee length leggings (long ones can be pushed up),

Lost Boys – Shorts or trousers and shirts in forest colours (greens, beige, brown)

Peter Pan – costume provided

Wendy – white vest and white leggings or shorts (nightgown provided)
