Re: Year 2 Trip to Sevenoaks Wildlife Reserve - Wed 21st June

As part of our topic on plants and habitats, we will be visiting the Sevenoaks Wildlife Reserve on Wednesday 21st June. This is a fantastic opportunity for our children to learn more about autochthonous plants and the characteristics of a woodlands habitat as well as exploring the outdoors whilst developing their resilience, independence and creativity. The children will take part in a Forest School experience and a Perfect Plants activity.

- Your child will need to arrive at school promptly that day (ideally by 8:40 am) to allow us to be on the coach which is leaving at 9:15 am.
- We will return by the end of the school day.
- Your child will need to wear their **PE Kit and trainers** for this trip and will need to bring a nut free packed lunch and a water bottle in a rucksack.

As school lunches are provided for all Infant age children as part of the Governments 'Free School Meals' programme, a packed lunch can be provided by the school. This will include a sandwich or roll with ham/cheese/tuna, a cookie/muffin and fruit.

If you would like to book a school packed lunch for the day, you will need to book by **Tuesday 6th June** by choosing the 'H' option on Scopay.

Please complete the sandwich on the attached permission slip.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure that the necessary precautions are taken and that we are made aware of this. If your child requires any medication for the day, please ensure that this is clearly labelled with their name and a medical form is completed and returned to the school office.

We invite you to make a contribution of £17.80 to cover the cost of the trip.
