

Year 6 Bikeability Level 2 Cycle Training

Dear Parents and Carers,

St Mary's has managed to secure some spaces for Bikeability Training (Level 2) for Year 6 pupils, to be completed at school throughout November. We currently have 64 places booked and children will be in groups of 8. In order to take part children must have a road-worthy bicycle and suitable helmet.

Places are booked through the Surrey website, using this link - https://surreycycletraining.online/public/school training/110871/

Registration for this course closes on Friday 29th September.

Places are allocated on a first-come, first served basis and once all 64 places are full, booking will no longer be available. After booking has closed, you will receive an email, stating which course your child is on.

The cost of the training is £15 and is payable when booking.

During the training, the children will learn how to use their bicycle safely on roads and near traffic with certified instructors. The children have 5 sessions (one each afternoon Monday - Friday for approximately 1 1/2 hours).

Please note that bicycles can be brought to school on the morning of the first session and can be locked up at school or stored indoors overnight throughout the week.

Skill level: In order to take part in the training children must be able to ride confidently including taking one hand off the handlebars and must be able to look behind while riding without losing control.

Level 2 Bikeability outcomes

- How to start and finish a journey
- Be aware of potential hazards
- Understand how and when to signal intentions to other road users
- Understand where to ride on roads in use by other vehicles
- Pass parked or slower moving vehicles
- Pass side road
- Turning into and out of road junctions- left from minor to major road, left from major to minor road, right from minor to major road, right from major to minor road
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of the decisions you make while cycling
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of the Highway Code
