Dear Parents and Carers,

Below is the final information for 'Confidently Me –An Evening of Song and Dance' at the Barn Theatre on Monday 25th April. *Please note all rehearsals will happen during school time on the day of the performance. Please can children wear PE kit to school on this day.*

Performance - Arrival time: 6:00 pm (show starts at 6:30pm)
Collection time: 7:45 approx

Children should arrive dressed in what they are wearing to perform. Year 5 dance club is performing first so children in dance club and choir should arrive ready to dance. All children need to be dropped at the stage door. Once children have been dropped off, parents are welcome to go straight into the theatre. The bar will be open. Collection is also from the stage door. If you are dropping and staying for the show, you are welcome to park in the theatre car park but please do adhere to their parking system.

Please be patient with us during the arrival and collection process as for child protection and safety reasons, all pupils will need to be signed in and out by an adult. We have a great number of children in the cast so this may take a little time. Children must be collected by an adult. We are unable to allow children to leave the theatre on their own to meet you elsewhere.

Costumes

Year 5 Dance Club: Messy school uniform – ripped tights, untucked shirts (tied up as a crop top is fine), messy hair (but must be tied back off face), ties tied around heads, graffiti on shirt etc. Ideally this should be mainly St Mary's colours. If you don't have a St Mary's tie but want to have one, any tie will do!

Year 6 Dance Club: Sparkly vest, acro shorts OR t shirt and shorts. This costume is being provided and will be sent home with the children in advance of the show so they can come dressed in it with their other clothing (for the opening number and choir) over the top.

Choir/Solo/Small group: Children should wear own clothes that make them feel confident and proud. Sparkles welcome!

Please remember:

- To supply your child with a bottle of water and small snack. No sweets or sticky foods!
- If needed: a change of costume (from dance to choir)
- Any medicines needed by your child. These should be clearly labelled, along with dosage instructions and handed to the person managing the stage door of The Barn. Asthma inhalers and EpiPens are to remain with your child in dressing rooms.
