Transition from Reception to Year 1

The transition to Year One from Reception is a **big** one. The Year 1 curriculum builds upon and extends the experiences that children have had in Reception. Learning through play will continue to be an important part of the school day, however, this will be in a much more structured fashion. This change is a difficult one for the children to adjust to and unfortunately we do get some tears each year. Formal learning will gradually increase to try and make this transition as easy for the children as possible. Hopefully this will ensure, that as the year goes on, they remain motivated, enthused and eager learners. Writing in Year One

Phonics will continue to be taught in groups and children will go up the colours as before. Remember this isn't a race and we want the children to be confident and actually understanding what they read. This year we will also start pre-cursive handwriting. This is the letters they have already learnt but with a lead in and a lead out. We have attached a sheet showing how the letters should be formed including the Read Write Inc rhymes. They cannot go onto pre-cursive until the can correctly form their letters.

We will continue to follow Maths Mastery and Power Maths, both of which thoroughly explore the composition of numbers, capacity, etc. The children will need to record their answers using St Mary's number format.
