In order for your child to receive this vaccination when we visit your school on **WEDNESDAY 22ND OCTOBER 2025**, please complete the e-consent form by **THURSDAY 16TH OCTOBER 2025**

- Please visit <u>www.surreyimmunisations.co.uk</u> and enter your school's unique code SR125194
- If you **do not** want your child to receive a vaccine, we would ask you to still complete a consent form but select the 'No' option.
- If you do not want your child to receive the nasal spray vaccine on the basis of its porcine gelatine content, please fill in the 'No' box indicating this, and you will be given the opportunity to consent for an alternative vaccination. This vaccination is delivered by injection into the arm and does not contain any porcine gelatine. We will deliver this in school when we visit. If, however, you would like your child to receive this vaccination in one of our clinics, please contact us on the above number or email.

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent from school.immunisations@nhs.net . If you do not receive this, please check your junk email.





Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
