

YEAR 4 BOUGH BEECH RESERVOIR & SCIENCE WORKSHOPS

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Spring Term, we have some exciting learning opportunities for the children; a trip to Bough Beech reservoir and some interactive science workshops. The Bough Beech trip will be before half term and the science workshops after half term. To make payment easier, we have included the cost of the workshops with the cost of the trip to Bough Beech.

We will be visiting the water treatment works at **Bough Beech Reservoir** in two groups. The focus of the trip will be; how the water is treated and the role of the reservoir in the water cycle. This trip links to our science topic and geography topic. The children will be given tours around the water treatment works as well as having a chance to walk to the top of the dam and through a tunnel under the dam.

- **4CH & 4OR - Friday 6th February 2026**
- Trainers or other appropriate footwear will be essential for walking around the treatment works
- A second pair of trainers or boots to change into for visiting the reservoir and dam will also be needed
- Children can wear PE uniform clothing appropriate for weather (e.g. navy jogging bottoms)
- Children will need a coat
- Children will need a packed lunch and a water bottle. They will not need to bring any money.
- We will be leaving school at the start of the school day. (Please ensure your child arrives **promptly by 8.45am.**)
- We will be returning to school by 3.20pm.

We invite you to make a contribution of £18.96 (online via Scopay) to cover the cost of the trip and further Science workshops. All contributions are voluntary but unfortunately, the trip cannot take place unless those who are able to contribute do so.
