Year 6 Residential Trip to Bowles 2027

Dear Parents/Carers,

As in previous years, Year 6 children will have the opportunity to take part in a residential week at the **Bowles Outdoor Activity Centre** at Eridge Green, near Tunbridge Wells. The visit to Bowles is an opportunity for the children to develop not only physical skills and academic ability but also to build social skills, awareness of others and is a chance to develop their independence before transferring to secondary education. The trip is a remarkable way to finish the children's time at primary school and creates memories that last a lifetime. Although it may seem a long time away, we are sharing this information now to allow you to spread payments over a longer period of time.

This year the Bowles residential week will be from **Monday 24th May 2027 to Friday 28th May 2027**.

Bowles is a non-profit making organisation that supports thousands of young people from all backgrounds to take part in outdoor education courses and activities all aimed at helping young people to grow and to develop in a beautiful, adventurous and challenging, yet safe environment. Bowles supports hundreds of schools and youth groups to help their young people get the best experiences possible – outcomes of the visit include improved self-confidence, resilience, physical and mental health, friendship and fun.

Included in the experience:

- 4 nights' accommodation in dorm style facilities (approximately 6 children to a room)
- 4 breakfasts, 4 hot lunches, 1 packed lunch (off site), 4 hot dinners
- Approximately 8 hours per day of instructor led activities, with activities throughout the day and every evening, including: rock climbing; swimming; kayaking (in a pool); two sessions of skiing; archery; team building; team ropes course; a whole day canoeing, kayaking and mega stand-up-paddleboards on a lake; orienteering and rock scrambling.
- All necessary equipment for outdoor activities and bedding (children only need to provide basic day to day clothing, shoes and light-weight gloves and socks for skiing)

Due to its non-profit making status, the Bowles Rocks Trust provide all of this for **£505 per child**. Please note that the cost does not include transport to and from the facility. In order to reduce costs, we ask that you to take and collect the children at either end of the week. Indeed, many parents have reported that this has been a positive experience for them and they appreciated the opportunity to see the environment for themselves. Please be reassured that if dropping off or collecting your child is a problem, we can support you in organising a lift share.

To secure your child's place, please complete the attached form. A **non-refundable** deposit of **£105 per pupil** is required by Bowles and this should be made by **Friday 18th September**.

Payment can be made via Scopay (our preferred method), or by cheque or cash given into the school office. If you pay by cash or cheque, you will be able to view your payment receipts on the Scopay system. Please note that payments of **any amount** can be added to Scopay at any time or paid in cash/cheque and if you prefer to pay weekly, you are more than welcome to do so.

If you wish to pay in instalments, we recommend paying the deposit in May/June followed by making **ten further monthly payments of £40** until April 2027.

The final payment is due by **Friday 16th April 2027**.
