**You are very welcome to watch the event and we ask that you enter the site via the Orange Gate between 8.45-9am or via Green Gate from 8.45am-11.15am approx. Exit will be at the Green Gate.**

- The run will start at 9.15am and finish around 11.15am
- *We ask that you do not bring snacks for your child or others during the Fun Run*
- Please ensure that your child is sent to school with a sun hat and sunscreen applied, if sunny, and has a water bottle that can be refilled at the water stations
