Y4 Ufton Court Residential Trip

Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

We have many exciting events happening over the forthcoming academic year, which will make learning great fun for the children. This includes a **one-night residential trip to Ufton Court** in October. This is the 7th year we have run this trip which links to our History Curriculum and really brings it to life!

- 2 Classes will be going on the trip on Monday 5th October and returning on Tuesday 6th October
- 2 Classes will be going on the trip on Tuesday 6th October and returning on Wednesday 7th October

There will be a talk about this trip on **Tuesday 8th September 2026 at 3.45pm in the Junior Hall.**

All information and materials used at this talk will be made available afterwards for those unable to attend.

Included in the experience:

- 1 night's accommodation in dorm style facilities in a Tudor Manor House
- 1 cooked breakfast, 2 lunches including 1 packed lunch (off site), 1 hot dinner
- Approximately 12 hours of expert instructor led activities including: an Anglo-Saxon Banquet, Saxon arts making a torch with metalwork skills, Saxon crime & punishment and the highlight of the trip – a raid by the Vikings!
- The trip is a wonderful experience and allows children to develop confidence and independence.

The price for this trip is **£174.00** per child. Please contact Mrs Woodward a.woodward@stmarysprimary.org in confidence if you have any difficulties regarding payment.

Payment can be made via Scopay (our preferred method), or by cheque or cash given into the school office. If you pay by cash or cheque, you will be able to view your payment receipts on the Scopay system.

There are 3 suggested options for payment below;

1. 1 payment: Full payment of £174.00 by 1st September
 2. 2 payments: Deposit of £50 (*required to secure a place on the trip*) by 1st August. Further payment of £124.00 by 25th September.
 3. 4 payments: Deposit of £50 (*required to secure a place on the trip*) by 26th June. 2 further payments of £50.00 due on 31st July and 28th August. One final payment of £24 by 18th September.
- Please note that payments of **any amount** can be added to Scopay or paid in cash/cheque at **any time** and if you prefer to pay weekly you are more than welcome to do so.
 - Please note all balances must be paid in full by Friday 25th September 2026.
