Re: EYFS Trip to Goring-by-Sea Beach Friday 3rd July 2026

As part of our topic on 'What's under the Sea', we will be visiting the beach at Goring-by-Sea. This is a fantastic opportunity for our children to learn more about a beach in the UK. The children will get the opportunity to experience rock pooling, building sandcastles and 'chasing the tide'.

Your child will need to arrive at school promptly that day (ideally by 8.40am) to allow us to be on the coach, which is leaving at 9am prompt. We will return by the end of the school day.

Your child will need to wear their **School PE Kit (and sensible shoes such as trainers or crocs)** for this trip and will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle in a rucksack.

As school lunches are provided for all Infant age children as part of the Governments 'Free School Meals' programme, a packed lunch can be provided by the school. This will include a sandwich or roll with ham/cheese/tuna, a cookie/muffin and fruit. If you would like to book a School packed lunch, please complete the sandwich choice on the attached permission slip by **Friday, 19th June** and we will order with the School Kitchen.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure that the necessary precautions are taken and that we are made aware of this. If your child requires any medication for the day, please ensure that this is clearly labelled with their name and a medical form is completed and returned to the school office.

We invite you to make a contribution of **£23 (online via Scopay)** to cover the cost of the trip. All contributions are voluntary but unfortunately, the trip cannot take place unless those that are able to contribute do so. Please contact us in confidence if you have any concerns or difficulties with making this contribution.
